Gregory is a passionate storyteller currently pursuing BA (Hons) Performance Making at Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts (NAFA), specialising in theatre. His work spans playwriting, directing, dramaturgy, and performance. In late 2024, he was inducted into the NAFA Talent Development Programme and is mentored by acclaimed playwright, Jean Tay. He co-wrote and performed in *Dancing With the Ghost of My Child* (M1 Fringe Festival 2025), directed by Noor Effendy Ibrahim and Ruby Jayaseelan. He also co-directed and served as a dramaturg for WOMENLY, a devised interdisciplinary work that interrogated evolving narratives of womanhood, presented at NAFA INterSPACE (Singapore Night Festival 2025).

Gregory has a profound interest in exploring narratives surrounding subtle influences and cultural currents that shape human behaviour and personal autonomy. As an aspiring interdisciplinary artist, he is committed to continuous learning and creative experimentation to refine his craft, completing Centre 42's An Introduction to the Dramaturg's Work course in August 2025.

With a background in Creative Writing for TV & New Media (Singapore Polytechnic), he has worked with Oak3 Films and Wonder Paradise International to conceptualise and write several serialised TV show concepts and submitted a documentary series pitch to Channel News Asia with Oak3.
